YOU'RE HIRED—It is with great joy and anticipation that the Board of Directors for CARS would like to announce the hiring of our first executive director who will begin on January 1, 2021. After much prayer and counsel, we have asked and are thankful that Brooke Chumley of Culpeper will take the mantle of this new 501c3 non-profit and lead us in our efforts to bring long term Christ-centered restorative care to those who are ready to be free of the ruin of addiction.



Brooke is a native of Culpeper County, born and raised. She is married with three children, 12, 6 and 9 months old. She believes the Lord gave her a mission of helping this community before she even entered high school. As a child, Brooke had a vision to change the world as any little girl does. A recent graduate of Liberty University with a bachelor's degree in Psychology, with a focus of Addiction and Recovery, Brooke has a heart for the broken and knows God has a calling on her life. She attends Lifepoint Church in Culpeper with her family and strongly embodies their philosophy that God calls each of us to know Him, find freedom, discover purpose and make a difference. Excited for this ministry, Brooke understands that this community and those surrounding it desperately need recovery options that reflect the heart of Jesus. She strongly believes that digging up roots of trauma, generational cycles and bondage combined with finding freedom from our past are key to breaking the chains of addiction. Those who are addicted and their families deserve to find and experience the freedom that God desires for each of us. She understands the hurt, pain and long-lasting effects that addiction can bring into the lives of adults, children, and families. God's word tells us to acknowledge Him in all of our ways and that includes in treatment and recovery.

Brooke first felt this pull to CARS on August 10, 2017 while sitting at a benefit concert hosted at Culpeper Baptist Church. Looking up at a giant overhead screen that displayed the idea and mission of CARS, she thought to herself, FINALLY, something

this community needs! With wide eyes, she leaned over to her husband and whispered with determination in her voice, “I’m going to be there one day.”. Although nothing more surfaced until about a year later, she stuck by her declaration. Brooke then began serving with CARS, attending Board of Supervisors meetings, and volunteering to support their fundraising efforts. She never once doubted that this was a God-sized dream about to come to life.

Brooke has spent the last roughly five years serving as the Community Outreach Coordinator at a local, well-known non-profit, SAFE (Services To Abused Families, Inc.). She worked diligently on bringing awareness and education to the topics of domestic violence and sexual assault to businesses, individuals, and organizations in Culpeper and surrounding counties. She also fostered community relations and networked to expand their mission. Serving in this capacity has made a major impact on her life as she has seen the power when the community takes steps of action in supporting local missions. Brooke feels honored to be chosen to lead the organization of CARS in a way that points to no one other than Jesus and His glory. She, as well as the rest of the community, is ready to see lives healed and hope restored.
